N2 CITY BLUEWATER BAY CHALLENGE INFORMATION GENERAL RULES

- 1. Organized in accordance with the rules and regulations of ASA and EPA. All athletes indemnify the National, Provincial and Regional bodies, sponsors and organizers against all and any actions of whatsoever nature.
- 2. Online entries are available on www.webtickets.co.za
- 3. Manual entries can be collected and submitted at Brian Bands in Cape Road.
- 4. Closing date for online entries will be Tuesday 13 January 2026 and manual entries on Wednesday 14 January at Brian Bands.
- 5. Collection of race numbers and late entries on Friday 16 January at Westbourne Oval, Westbourne Road, Central between 12h00 and 18h00, and on the morning of the race at the venue. Race number contains a chip and must not be folded.
- 6. The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
- 7. All traffic Officials and marshals **must be obeyed**.
- 8. The wearing of earphones or headsets is not permitted due to safety reasons and may lead to disqualification.
- 9. No prams allowed on the 15km route, but will be allowed on the 5km, at your own risk
- 10. Medals will be awarded to all finishers.
- 11. Race venue is an alcohol-free zone.
- 12. The 15 km Race will start at 06h00 at the Bluewater Bay N2 Shopping Centre, and the 5km will start at 06h15.
- 13. Athletes are required to arrive well in advance due to expected traffic congestion.
- 14. The minimum age on the day of the race is 15 years for the 15km.
- 15. The cut off time is at 08h30 (2hrs 30min) for the 15km, and 07h30 for the 5km.
- 16. Prize giving and club gazebo's will be allowed in designated area.
- 17. Prize winners must be dressed in their club colours during the award presentation.
- 18. Athletes must run in official Club colours with the Official race number clearly visible on the front and 2025/26 licence number on the front and back of the vest.
- 19. Athletes who are not licensed members of a club affiliated to ASA must purchase a temporary licence.
- 20. Age category tags must be visible on front and back of your vest if you wish to qualify forcategory prizes. Athletes may be requested to provide proof of age on race day.
- 21. Registered athletes are covered by a group personal insurance scheme. Temporary licenced athletes have no cover and are urged to join an affiliated club.
- 22. Please obey parking marshals.
- 23. Food will be available at the local shopping centre in the finish area.
- 24. Athletes must run facing traffic at all times, unless instructed otherwise by a marshal.
- 25. No personal seconding will be allowed on the route. For the safety of the athletes, please do not drive on the route.
- 26. Refuse bins will be placed up to 500m after the water stations. Please discard all litter (sachets/bottles/cups/other) into the bins provided and not beyond the designated points. Disposing litter outside the demarcated zone may result in disqualification.
