#### **RACE RULES**

The race will be subject to the rules of the **WA**, **ASA** and **KZN Athletics**. All licensed runners are expected to participate in this race displaying 2025/2026 license number front and back of their vests - **NOT shorts**.

Participants must be 16 years and older for the 21km and 14 years and older for the 10km.

All participants must wear their Provincial Athletics Approved Club Colours as well as ASA/KZNA age category tags and/or walker tags on both the front and back of their vests to qualify for Age Category and Walker Prizes.

All participants must obey Technical Officials, Race Officials, Marshals and Traffic Officers.

No pacing allowed. No personal seconding allowed. Refreshment stations are being provided, so no mobile seconds allowed on route. No physical assistance anywhere on route including at the finish line.

Foreign athletes must abide by WA Rules CR 1.7, TR 4.1 and 4.2 and ASA Rule 9.

All unlicensed entrants require a temporary license. Temporary licensed athletes are not covered by the ASA National Insurance Policy.

Unlicensed athletes must run in neutral colours and adhere to WA and ASA advertising rules. Holders of temporary licenses will be eligible for individual prizes and may claim Age Category prizes in keeping with WA and ASA Rules.

New ASA/KZNA age categories (60-80) and walker tags to be worn front and back of vests and be clearly visible.

PLEASE NOTE: By signing the INDEMNITY / WAIVER section on the Race Entry form, all participants release the Organiser, Sponsors, Partners, ASA and KZNA from any liability.
