RULES

- All foreign athletes must abide by WA rules CR1.7, TR4.1, TR4.2 and ASA Rule 9.
- Foreign athletes to contact the race organiser.
- The race is run in accordance with and subject to WA, ASA and KZNA rules.
- Runners must be 20 years or older for 50km on race day.
- Runners must be 19 years older for 25km on race day.
- Runners must be 14 years or older for 10km on race day.
- KZNA Approved age category and walker tags must be worn on back and front of the vest/ crop top and must be clearly visible in order to qualify for age category prizes.
- 2026 license numbers must be worn on back and front of the vest/ crop top and must be clearly visible.
- Temporary license on back of vest/ crop top must be clearly visible with the race number on the front. Temporary licensed athletes are not covered by a national medical insurance policy, ASA Rule 25.6.15. Unregistered athletes running with temporary licenses must run in neutral colours and adhere to WA advertising Regulations. Holders of temporary licenses will be eligible for individual prizes and may qualify for age category prizes in keeping with WA and ASA rules.
- Prize giving will commence at 10:30am.
- 50km is a comrades marathon qualifier: 6hrs 09min 59sec.
- Personal seconding will not be allowed.
- Results on clubs website.
- Disqualified athletes will not be eligible for any incentives.
- T-shirts for first 500 entrants.
- Cut off for 50km is 7 hours.
- Proof of age may be required for age category athletes.
- Participants must obey the race officials, marshalls and traffic officers.
- Your entry fee will not be refunded if you do not participate.
- The race number must be worn over the permanent license number on the front of the upper body clothing and be placed so that the ASA license sponsor and the ASA province/ year remain visible above the race number (ASA Rule 26.1.7).
- Junior athletes must be 19 years and younger on the 31st December in the day of the competition, must wear a 'J' on the upper front and back of vest/ crop top in order to be eligible for prizes and must provide proof of age on race day.
- Winners prize money will be paid electronically subject to KZNA clearance.

All entrants must ensure that they are medically fit to run and fully understand that they run at their own risk and organisers will not be held responsible for any injury or illness during or as a result of the race for any property lost or damage on this course or in the changing area.
