### RACE RULES





- The Tyger Run/Walk is run in accordance with the rules of ASA and WPA.
- The Tyger Run/Walk half marathon & 10km are open to all licenced and non-licenced runners of 16 years and older for the Half Marathon and 14 years and older for the 10km.
- Licence'd runners should wear club colours. Registered athletes must wear their ASA licences on the front and back of their vest. Official event race number to be worn on the front. The race number must be worn on the front of the vest, partially covering the ASA licence, so that the ASA licence sponsor remains visible. Temporary licenced runners must wear the race number on the front of their vest and the temporary licence on the back.
- Temporary licences are available at R60 for the 21.1km and R40 for the 10km Senior and R25 for 10km Junior events.

  Temporary licenced participants are eligible for age category prizes provided they enter the relevant age group, wear the appropriate age tags and provide proof of age.
- Temporary licence holders when registering must complete and hand in the tear off strip from the unumber in order to be eligible to compete.
- Unlicensed runners must wear plain clothes (no advertising permitted). Official event race number to be worn on the front and the
- temporary licence number on the back.

  Age category tags must be worn (front and back) and visible for the entire race to be eligible for any age category prize including Juniors.
- Personal seconding is not permitted except at official refreshment stations. Private vehicles are requested not to follow the athletes

  In addition to overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter.

  Corresponding numerical age category tags must be worn on the front and back of their club vest. Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their chronological age or any younger category down to senior. Proof of age is required for category prizes.

  Club colours must be worn to qualify for team prizes.

- Juniors (born from 2001 onwards) wearing a junior or a senior licence must wear an age category tag to qualify for age group prizes. No swopping of race numbers as the race number is linked to your name and finishing time and may result in your disqualification. 13
- Each race distance has a different race number range and colour with your data captured electronically. Do not transfer
- between races without notifying the race organisers.

  All traffic officers and marshals must be obeyed.
- The race organisers reserve the right to accept or reject any entry.
- Foreign athletes must comply with IAAF rule 4.2 and all relevant race and domestic rules. The athletes must be able to produce the letter from his/her federation permitting participation on race day. 18
- The entry fee is non-refundable.
- Kilometer markers will be placed at each kilometer mark.
  Refreshment stations will be situated approximately every 3km along the route. 20.
- Medals will be handed to all finishers.
- There will be tog bag facilities. Bags dropped off at runners' own risk. The organiser will not be held responsible for any loss or damages. Toilets will be available at the start and finish.
