THE RACE RULES

1. The race is held in line with rules of CAAR5, Athletics South Africa (“ASA”) and Athletics Gauteng North (“AGN”).
 2. The event is open for all South African athletes and International Athletes across the world.
 3. International athletes competing must adhere to WA Rules (WA Rule 4.2).
 4. Athletes should participate with the provided race bib (to wear in front) and the 2 (two) ASA 2025 Permanent License number (back & front) or the Temporary number at the back.
 5. Race number must be visible at all times and worn on the front of the upper outer garment.
 6. Non-registered / non club member athletes in are required to purchase a temporary licence in addition to the race entry fee and this number must be worn at the back of their vest.
 7. 1 mile for athletes with disability.
 8. Permanent Licensed athletes should participate in their full club colours.
 9. International Foreign Athletes will be allocated a temporary License Number and must produce clearance from their member federation if are contenders for Prizes.
 10. Athletes who belong to clubs should be licensed for 2025.
 11. The Prize money offered will be paid in EFT within 60 days.
 12. Athletes in the age category prize may be requested to produce proof of identity before awarded prize money.
 13. Any athletes who cannot on request produce acceptable proof of age documents will be afforded three days in which to comply, failing which he/she will not qualify for any age group prize.
 14. Category Age Athletes (juniors and Masters) must wear their age categories.
 15. An athlete may only compete in the age category displayed in his/her vest. Thus, a master will not qualify for any veteran or prizes.
 16. Medals will be awarded to all finishers
 17. No athletes under the age of 14 years will be allowed to run the 10 km race.
 18. Athletes under the age of 9 years will be allowed to participate in the 5km, provided that their parent/guardian accompanies them at all times.
 19. Marshalls, traffic, police, and all race officials must be obeyed at all times. If athletes are instructed to stop by any medical, race, traffic or police officials, they shall do so immediately.
 20. For safety reasons, the use of personal music players with earphones or headphones is not allowed. Any person using such device in contravention of WA TR6.3 or ASA Rule 34.10 shall not be eligible for individual or team prizes and may be disqualified.
 21. Entries capped at 8000 runners.
 22. No animals are allowed to accompany an athlete during any event.
 23. Entry fees are non-transferable and non-refundable.
 24. The athlete grants their permission, in terms of Section 51 of the Electronic Communications Transactions Act 25 of 2002, to the organisers to use their name, race information, and photographs, video tapes, broadcasts and telecasts in which they may appear free of charge. Organisers are compliant with the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 (POPIA) and is committed to storing, using, and processing participant data in a manner compliant with the guidelines prescribed by POPIA.
- Participants accepts that their personal information will remain confidential and hereby consent to same being shared with the parties involved in the organisation of the event for purposes of results, medical care, and/or promotion of activities related to the event.
