Entry & Race Rules

1. Age category tags must be worn (front and back) and be visible for the entire race to be eligible for any age category prize; including juniors.
2. Water and Coke will be available along the route and at the finish. Participants are encouraged to carry their own.
3. Prize giving will be soon after 9:00, which includes the awarding of lucky draw prizes.
4. The organisers, sponsors, landlord, and its employees, agents, representatives, contractors, managers, WPA or any other acting under the landlord's control (collectively called "the owner") shall not be responsible or liable for any claim, loss or damage arising or suffered by any person participating in this activity, including but not limited to personal injury, or death, or any harm caused to any person or for damages, loss or destruction of any person arising from negligence by the owner or theft or from any other cause whatsoever. Participants in this event do so at their own risk and release and discharge the organisers, sponsors, Provincial and National Athletic Bodies and all persons assisting in staging the event from any responsibility relating to any injury, loss or damage of whatever nature, however caused, arising directly or indirectly from their participation in the event. 5. Detailed rules are available on www.wpa.org.za, by request from the organisers or the WPA office.
6. Protection of Personal Information - Runners agree that their personal information is provided to the race organiser to organise the event. Such information may be shared with Entry Ninja, to enter the race and for timing.
7. The race is run according to the rules of ASA and WPA
8. Runners must obey the traffic officials, race officials and marshals at all times.
9. Minimum age for the 15km is 15 years (on the date of the race)
10. No personal seconding is allowed along the route.
11. The cut-off time for the 15k race is 2 hours 45min (8:45)
12. Licensed runners should run in club colours and must display a valid ASA number on the front and back of the running vest and must be visible throughout the race.
13. One race number (bib) will be issued and must be worn on the front of the vest partially covering the ASA race number so that the ASA race number sponsors logo is visible.
14. Non-licensed runners must purchase a temporary license that must be completed, and the strip handed in at the registration or the start to be eligible to run.
15. The use of music players with headphones is not allowed and may result in disqualification.
16. In addition to the Overall (open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age group in which they entered. Corresponding numerical age tags must be worn on the front and back of their club vests. Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their numerical age or younger category down to senior.
17. Temporary licensed participants are eligible for age category prizes, provided they enter the relevant age group, wear the appropriate age tags and provide proof of age.
18. Athletes wearing age category tags must ensure they are visible for the entire duration of the race

Start/Finish: False Bay College, Westlake Drive

Turn-around Point: 7.5 km

Begin at False Bay TVET College Campus, Westlake Drive, Westlake.

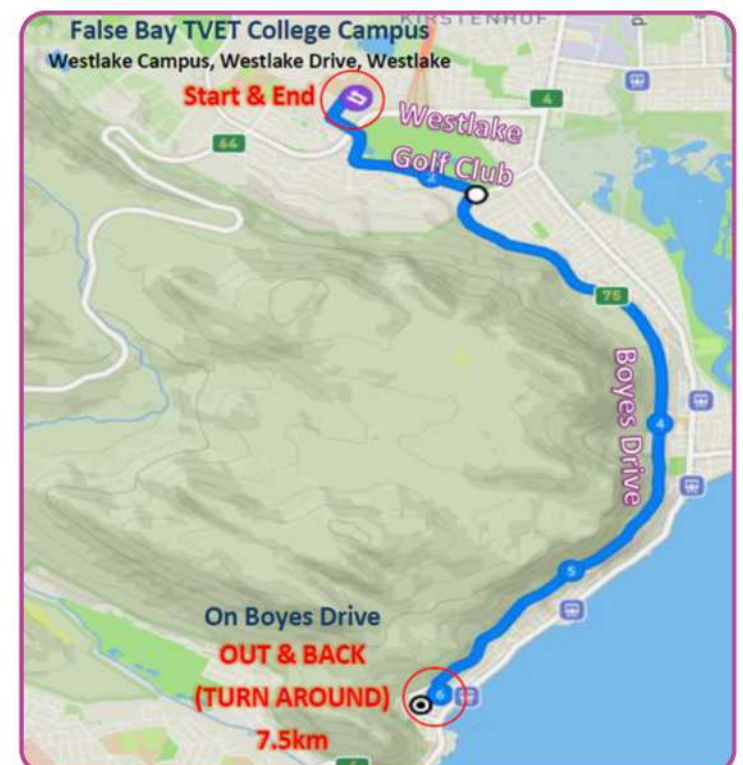
Outbound (7.5 km to turn-around point):

1. Head out from the college onto Westlake Drive.
2. Continue along Westlake Drive, keeping the Westlake Golf Club on your left-hand side.
3. Follow the road as it passes Stonehurst Mountain Estate (on your right).
4. Continue straight until you reach Boyes Drive.
5. Stay on Boyes Drive, enjoying the open views and rolling gradient.
6. At the 7.5 km mark, marshals will be present and the 7.5km marker will indicate the turn-around, where you will reach the designated turn-around point on Boyes Drive.

Return (7.5 km back to finish): Turn back along Boyes Drive, retracing your steps.

Run all the way back along Westlake Drive.

Finish: End the 15 km route back at False Bay TVET College Campus, Westlake Drive, Westlake



Prizes

- In addition to overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter.
- Corresponding numerical age category tags must be worn on the front and back of their club vest
- Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their chronological age or any younger category down to senior.
- Temporary licensed participants are eligible for age category prizes provided they enter the relevant age group, wear the appropriate age tags and provide proof of age.
- Juniors born in 2006 or later must display the age tags "J" to qualify for a prize.
- ASA WPA Licenses valid for 2025 must be worn on the front and back of the vest.
