## EVENT INFORMATION

1. Manual entries can be done at Brian Bands and Action Sports Summerstrand. Entries at Sports shops close on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> October at 17H00.
2. Collection of race numbers and late entries at the Crusaders Club (St. Georges Cricket Stadium, Park Drive on Friday the 16<sup>th</sup> of October 2026 from 16H00 to 19H00 and from 05H00 on Saturday morning at African Sky's. Card facilities will be available. The race committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
3. A receipt/proof of payment may be required in case of any discrepancy with pre-entries.
4. The race venue will be at African Sky's, 120 Nassau Road, Theescombe.
5. Official 2026 ASA licence number to be worn on the front and back of the vest and the official race number placed over the licence number on the front of vest. The race number contains a chip and must under no circumstances be folded.
6. Age category identification must be clearly visible on the front and back of running vests to be eligible for prizes. Runners who are wearing temporary licences must wear a category age tag and present proof of age on race day to qualify for age-category prizes.
7. Cut-off time for 21.1km – 09H30 and 10km – 08H20. No timing for the 5km event.

8. Prizegiving will be at 08H00 for 5km and at 10H00 for the 21.1km & 10km. Prize winners must be dressed in their club colours during the award presentation.
9. Tog bag storage facility and safe key storage are available at the start venue.
10. Club gazebos are welcome. One vehicle per club will be allowed inside this area.
11. Toilet facilities are available at the start/finish.
12. No alcohol will be allowed to be brought onto the premises.
13. Food and refreshments will be on sale at the venue.

#### **GENERAL RULES**

1. Registered athletes must run in their official Club colours.
2. Unlicensed runners will receive one Temporary licence number to be worn on the back of their running shirts. Race number on front of shirt. Temporary licence holders must wear a plain t-shirt or vest.
3. **Participation in wheelchairs, prams, baby joggers or running with animals are not permitted in all distances.**
4. Disabled or blind runners are to be accompanied and may only make use of guides who have officially entered the event.
5. Registered athletes are covered by a group personal accident insurance scheme. Details may be obtained from your club/province.
6. Temporary licensed athletes are **NOT** covered by the ASA Insurance Scheme and are urged to join an affiliated club. Completion of the tear-off strip is compulsory.
7. Competitors must be **16 years of age for 21.1km and 14 years of age for the 10km and 9 years of age for 5km** on the race day.
8. **The wearing of earphones or headsets is prohibited and will lead to disqualification.**

#### **ROUTE**

1. PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE ON THE ROUTE.
2. Route maps will be released closer to the event.
3. No personal seconding is allowed. Race Officials and Marshals are always to be obeyed. Run on the right-hand side of the road unless instructed otherwise by a Marshal.

#### **PARKING AND ROAD CLOSURES**

1. **NO PARKING** is allowed inside or in front of the venue. Parking will be on Sonop Street Road (behind the venue). Parking will be clearly indicated and there will be a walkway to the start/finish.
2. Road Closures will be communicated once approved by Traffic.

#### **REFRESHMENT STATIONS**

1. Refreshment tables will serve water sachets at all points.
2. Intentional littering and littering in non-designated areas may lead to instant disqualification. Our waterpoint staff are all volunteers. Please do not drop your empty sachets on the ground but disperse into a bin provided.
