1. ONLINE:

Closing date for online entries, is midnight on Sunday 12th April 2020. **Please note if payment is not received within 72 hours of entry, your entry will be deleted.**

2. FAX:

Complete your entry form and fax it along with your deposit slip to (021) 510 7230. Closing date for fax entries is Sunday 5th April 2020.

3. INSTORE ENTRIES:

Hand deliver your entry form and cash to a cashier in any of the Sportsmans Warehouse stores marked below. You will receive two till slips, one to be stapled onto your entry form and the other serves as proof of your entry. Please bring this with you to number collection. Closing date for in-store entries Sunday 5th April 2020.

8. CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY:

1. Fax, in-store and online entries will receive a confirmation email (if an email address is provided by you.)
2. Prior to number collection you will receive a sms indicating your race number and number collection venue you selected on your entry form.
3. Please bring proof of your entry, email confirmation or sms confirmation with you to number collection at the store you selected on your entry form.

2. NO NUMBER COLLECTION WILL TAKE PLACE ON RACE DAY.
3. COMPULSORY DISPOSABLE CHIP: the purchase and use of a disposable chip at a cost of R25.00 is compulsory for all events except the 5km fun run/walk. This fee is included in your entry fee.

10. TOP EVENTS COMPULSORY DISPOSABLE TIMING CHIP:

1. 1 x Top Events Disposable timing chip will be placed on the front of your race number and covered by a foam strip on the back.
2. PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE THIS. IF YOU DO YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE AN OFFICIAL TIME.
3. The strip is to prevent water and body fluids from affecting the chip signal. Please do not bend or fold your race number for this could affect the antennae and also the signal capability of the chip.

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RACE RULES

1. The Safari Half Marathon is run in accordance with the rules of ASA and Boland Athletics.
2. The Safari 21.1km and 10km is open to all licenced and non-licenced runners of 14 years and older for the 10km and 16 years and older for the 21.1km.
3. Licenced runners should wear club colours. Official event race number to be worn on the front. Registered athletes must wear their ASA licences on the front and back of their vest. The race number must be worn on the front of the vest, partially covering the ASA licence, so that the ASA licence sponsor remains visible. Temporary licenced runners must wear the race number on the front of their vest and the temporary licence on the back.
4. Temporary licences are available at R40 for the 21.1km and 10km events.
5. Temporary licenced participants are eligible for age category prizes provided they enter the relevant age group, wear the appropriate age tags and provide proof of age.
6. Unlicenced runners must wear plain clothes (no advertising permitted). Official event race number to be worn on the front and the temporary licence number on the back.
7. Personal seconding is not permitted. Private vehicles are requested not to follow the athletes on the route.
8. In addition to overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter. Corresponding numerical age category tags must be worn on the front and back of their club vest. Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their chronological age or any younger category down to senior.
- 9. Athletes competing for a category prize must wear age category tags (on the front and the back).**
- 10. No swapping of race numbers or chips as these are linked to your name and finishing time and will result in disqualification.**
11. Juniors must provide proof of age to qualify for prize money.
12. All traffic officers and marshals must be obeyed.
13. Proof of age is required for category prizes.
14. The race organisers reserve the right to accept or reject any entry.
15. Foreign athletes must comply with IAAF rule 4.2 and all relevant race and domestic rules. The athletes must be able to produce the letter from his/her federation permitting participation on race day.
16. Kilometre markers will be placed at each kilometre mark.
17. Refreshments stations will be situated approximately every 3km.
18. Medals will be handed to all finishers within the cut off time of 11:15.
19. Results will be available on www.topevents.co.za and www.safarihalmarathon.co.za
20. Prize-Giving will take place between 11:15 and 11:30.
21. The club house and school toilets will be closed on race day, please make use of the portable toilets provided.
- 22. No ambush marketing.**
23. There will be a tog bag facility for use at athlete's own risk in the school hall. Cell phones, money & jewellery are not to be left in tog bags. No bag tag, no bag. Tog bags must be collected by 11:00.
24. FREE parking will be available at the following venues: Huguenot Junior School & Boland Rugby Grounds.

26. There are no shower facilities at the venue.
