Running under the spectacular peaks of the Drakensberg Mountains, the Josiah Gumede 10km Challenge event celebrates the life of Josiah Gumede, the 4th President of the ANC and is one of the cornerstone highlights of the Drakensberg Extravaganza.

START TIMES & LOCATIONS

Registration and the Start and Finish of the race is at the Bergville Sports Centre, Golf Road Bergville. Registration to collect race numbers and race shirts is Friday 27 November 2020 15h00 to 18h00 and Saturday 28 November 2020, 04h00 – 05h30. The race starts at 06h00.

ROUTE

The race starts and finishes on the field at the Bergville Sports Centre. The route turns left onto Golf Road, right onto the R74 and left onto the P288. At the 5km turn around point on the P288 the route returns the same way back to the sports ground.

RULES

- Entries close 17h00 on Tuesday 24 November 2020 or when 500 entries have been received. There are no late entries. No substitution will be permitted.
- Race numbers and shirts can be collected at Registration at the Bergville Sports Centre on Friday 27 November 2020 from 15h00 to 18h00 and on Saturday 28 November 2020 from 04h00 to 05h30
- Entrance to the Bergville Sports Centre and Registration will be strictly controlled observing Covid 19 protocols. Every person entering the Bergville Sports Centre will be required to wear a mask, will have their temperature taken and will be required to complete a health questionaire.

Hand sanitising and social distancing will be followed.

- All entrants receive a quality moisture management race shirt. These can be collected at Registration, the organisers reserve the right to substitute sizes for those requested.
- All athletes must be licenced. Licenced runners must wear their club colours together with their 2020 licence numbers on the front and back of their vest and the Josiah Gumede race number on the front of their vest. The race number must be placed over the licence number so that the province, year and ASA sponsor logo is visible.
- Unlicenced athletes must wear a temporary licence. These athletes must
 wear plain colour (with no advertising), the temporary licence on the back
 of their vest and the Josiah Gumede race number on the front of their vest.
 No licence number to be worn on shorts. Temporary licence numbers will
 be available for collection at Registration. Temporary licences will not be
 sold at Registration.
- The Josiah Gumede 10km Challenge is held under the rules of AthleticsSouth Africa (ASA), KwaZulu Natal Athletics (KZNA) and the International Association of Athletics Federation (IAAF).
- All foreign athletes must comply with IAAF rule 4.2, rule 22.1 and rule 142 and ASA rule 9.
- Entrants must be at least 14 years of age on the day of the race
- The ASA/KZNA approved numerical age category tags (60mm 80mm) must be worn on the back and front of athletes vests for those competing for category prizes. Proof of age must be provided on request before or after the race.
- A secure tog bag area will be available on the day of the race at the Bergville Sports Centre.
- Athletes are to obey traffic officials, technical officials, Covid 19 compliance staff, event marshalls and safety officers at all times.
- No personal seconding is allowed.
- $\bullet \quad \text{No blades or wheel chairs or mechanically operated devices are allowed}.$

- No ipods or any other form of earphone type device may be used during the race.
- No pets are allowed in the race.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded, cancelled returned or exchanged on account of weather or unforseen events occurring beyond the control of the event organisers, the race director, the host club or the sponsors.
- The Josiah Gumede 10km Challenge supports and promotes the clean running campaign. Please help our event and our sport and throw your coke cups and water sachets in the bins provided.
